

**EIGHTH AMENDMENT TO QUILT VENDOR
CIS MASTER SERVICE AGREEMENT**

This EIGHTH AMENDMENT ("Eighth Amendment") to the Quilt Vendor CIS Master Service Agreement ("MSA") is dated as of this 25th day of September, 2017 (the "Effective Date") and is by and between The Quilt, Inc. ("Quilt") and Level 3 Communications, LLC ("Level 3").

WHEREAS, Quilt and Level 3 are parties to the Quilt Vendor CIS Master Service Agreement, dated June 12, 2008, as amended, pursuant to which Level 3 provides commodity Internet services to certain specified authorized buyers;

WHEREAS, for the promises contained herein and for other valuable consideration, Quilt and Level 3 now wish to amend the Agreement as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, Quilt and Level 3 agree as follows:

1. **Definitions.** Terms defined in the Agreement shall have the same meaning herein unless otherwise specified.
2. **Effective Date of Amendment.** Except as otherwise noted herein, modifications to the Agreement specified in this Addendum shall be effective as of the Amendment Date.
3. **Authorized Quilt Buyers.** Exhibit A containing the list of Authorized Quilt Buyers is hereby deleted and replaced with Exhibit A attached hereto.
4. **Pricing.** Exhibit B is hereby deleted and replaced with Exhibit B attached hereto.
5. **Ratification.** All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and shall continue in full force and effect.

Pricing Schedule

Each Authorized Buyer taking services from Level 3 under the Agreement will make a commitment to Level 3 to purchase a minimum of amount of Level 3 High Speed IP based on the circuit bandwidth in the table below.

Each Authorized Buyer's price per month per Mbps of Level 3 provided Level 3 High Speed IP Service shall be prospectively adjusted by Level 3 each calendar quarter during the term of service, with such adjusted pricing being applicable to Level 3 High Speed IP Service delivered during the calendar quarter immediately following the adjustment. Pricing adjustments will be made by Level 3 by aggregating the contractual commitments for Level 3 High Speed IP Service (committed data rates ("CDR")) of all Authorized Buyers with whom Level 3 has agreed, and applying those aggregated commitments ("QACDR") and adjusting pricing per Mbps for all Authorized Buyers in accordance with the chart below:

Tiered Aggregation Usage Review

Provider will extend price reductions to Authorized Quilt Buyers (AQB's) when the aggregate CDR of all AQB's purchasing service from Provider (including the CDRs of AQB's purchasing Services from Provider exceeds one of the volume tiers set forth in the table below and the AQB's sign new Service Orders for a minimum term of 12 months. Pricing adjustments will be made as follows.
