

SIXTH AMENDMENT TO QUILT VENDOR CIS MASTER SERVICE AGREEMENT

This Sixth Amendment to the Quilt Vendor CIS Master Services Agreement effective May 2, 2008 ("Sixth Amendment") is entered into by and between **tw telecom holdings inc.** f/k/a Time Warner Telecom Holdings Inc. ("TWTC") and The Quilt, Inc. ("The Quilt"). This Sixth Amendment is effective upon execution by both parties ("Sixth Amendment Effective Date").

WHEREAS, TWTC and The Quilt entered into the Quilt Vendor CIS Master Services Agreement effective May 2, 2008, which was revised and extended by the First Amendment to Quilt Vendor CIS Master Service Agreement effective September 10, 2010 ("First Amendment"), the Second Amendment to Quilt Vendor CIS Master Service Agreement effective June 7, 2012 ("Second Amendment"), the Third Amendment to Quilt Vendor CIS Master Service Agreement effective November 29, 2012 ("Third Amendment"), the Fourth Amendment to Quilt Vendor CIS Master Service Agreement effective July 18, 2013, and the Fifth Amendment to Quilt Vendor CIS Master Service Agreement effective February 28, 2014 (collectively the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement to update the pricing available to Authorized Buyers as well as the schedule of Authorized Quilt Buyers.

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration the sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Authorized Buyers. The list of Authorized Buyers attached to the Second Amendment as Exhibit A-2 is replaced and superseded by the updated list in new Exhibit A-3 attached to this Sixth Amendment and incorporated by this reference.
2. Pricing Terms. The Pricing Schedule attached to the Fifth Amendment as Exhibit B-4 is replaced and superseded by the revised Pricing Schedule in new Exhibit B-5 attached to this Sixth Amendment and incorporated by this reference. The references to Exhibit B-4 in Paragraph 1 of the Agreement shall be deemed to refer to Exhibit B-5. The prices shown in Exhibit B-5 apply as of the Sixth Amendment Effective Date.
3. Savings; Order of Precedence. Except as amended herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect. If there is a conflict between this Sixth Amendment and the Agreement, the terms of this Sixth Amendment shall govern.

PRICING SCHEDULE

Authorized Buyers will be charged monthly prices for Internet Service in accordance with the Authorized Quilt Buyer's (AQB) desired Service Delivery Option, Port, and selected bandwidth level.

Price reductions will be applied to Internet services purchased by both existing and future **tw telecom** Quilt customers. In the event that TWTC agrees in writing with any Authorized Buyer to reduce the prices below for particular bandwidth levels, **tw telecom** will re-price existing affected customers receiving service at the same bandwidth upon start of the customer's next 30-day billing cycle. Authorized Buyers will not be required to execute a new contract to receive the new price.

All prices are for service terms of at least twelve (12) months. Longer service terms are available upon request. Service terms will automatically renew for one year periods unless terminated by either party upon written notice given at least sixty (60) days before the end of the service term.
