

# Wabash College: Before

- 1Gbps total campus Internet bandwidth
- Internet2 access through regional partner (I-Light), but service through leased circuit and bandwidth saturated with commodity traffic
- On-campus paths to science buildings also 1Gbps
- Significant impediment to research; one researcher resorted to shipping hard drives to transfer data

## Wabash College: After

- Direct fiber connection to I-Light, 10Gbps
- Science buildings 10GBps
- Science DMZ
- Network bottleneck eliminated
- Expanded research capacity, both in size of data sets and number of experimental runs
